July was an awesome month! As I mentioned in my last letter, I have been meeting with 5 different men throughout the week to mentor and disciple them. I am glad to share with you that one of them, Esaú who is 19 years old, has shared with me that God is calling him to full-time ministry. Of course, there is much to do now as far as future steps, but for now I am just glad that there are fellow Mexicans who are willing to answer the call. In addition to these weekly meetings, I have started a discipleship class on Sunday mornings. I am very burdened to help train mature and new believers to become disciplers. We are averaging a class of 35 students and it has been a delight to see their faith strengthened and their eagerness to soon disciple others. Our goal in partnering with this local church is two-fold. First, to encourage those who have been called to ministry to surrender, and second, to help with the spiritual growth of the members so that they can become a strong, doctrinally-minded mother church in this area. We pray for their growth both physically and spiritually because it will be beneficial to the churches that we plant in the following years. Sunday nights I have been preaching a series on Matthew. It has been 5 weeks since the series started and we are in chapter 3! What a delight to dwell in the Word of God by using expository preaching. In the near future, we will begin an expository preaching workshop to train future pastors and to help men to learn how to properly study, interpret and preach the Bible.
